A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to dairy marketing; generally prohibiting retail sale and distribution of raw milk; specifying 2 requirements for sales and distribution of raw milk; 3 requiring warning statements; requiring registration of 4 farms or dairies selling raw milk; providing for sampling 5 of raw milk; making conforming amendments; and providing 6 7 for an effective date. 8 9 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming: 10 11 Section 1. W.S. 11-36-111 is created to read: 12 11-36-111. Raw milk. 13

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2 (a) The acquisition of raw milk from cows or goats by a consumer for use or consumption by the consumer shall not 3 constitute the sale of raw milk and shall not be prohibited 4 if all of the following conditions are met: 5 6 7 (i) The owner of a cow, goat, cow shares or goat shares receives raw milk directly from the farm or dairy 8 where the cow, goat or dairy herd is located and the farm 9 10 or dairy is registered pursuant to subsection (b) of this section. A person who is the owner of a cow share or goat 11 12 share in a cow, goat or dairy herd may receive raw milk on 13 behalf of another owner of the same cow, goat or dairy 14 herd. A person who is not an owner of a cow share or goat share in the same cow, goat or dairy herd shall not receive 15 raw milk on behalf of the owner of a cow share or goat 16 17 share; 18

19 (ii) The milk is obtained pursuant to a cow share20 or a goat share;

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(iii) A prominent warning statement that the milkis not pasteurized is delivered to the consumer with the

1 milk or is displayed on a label affixed to the milk
2 container;

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4 (iv) Information describing the standards used by 5 the farm or dairy with respect to herd health, and in the 6 production of milk from the herd, is provided to the 7 consumer by the farmer together with results of tests 8 performed on the cows or goats that produced the milk, 9 tests performed on the milk and an explanation of the tests 10 and test results.

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12 (b) Registration of a farm or dairy as required by 13 paragraph (a)(i) of this section shall be accomplished by 14 delivering to the department a written statement 15 containing:

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17 (i) The name of the farmer, farm or dairy;18

19 (ii) A valid, current address of the farmer, farm 20 or dairy; and 21

(iii) A statement that raw milk is being producedat the farm or dairy.

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2 (c) No person shall sell or offer to sell raw,
3 unpasteurized milk in Wyoming, except as provide din this
4 section.

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6 (d) No person who, as a consumer, obtains raw milk in 7 accordance with this section shall sell or redistribute the 8 milk.

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10 (e) No producer of raw milk shall publish any 11 statement that implies approval or endorsement by the 12 department.

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14 (f) No person shall sell or offer for sale any raw 15 milk for other than human consumption unless it has first 16 been treated with a dye approved by the department.

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(g) For purposes of this section, "a cow share" or "a goat share" is an undivided interest in a cow, goat or herd of cows or goats, created by a written contractual relationship between a consumer and a farmer that includes a legal bill of sale to the consumer for an interest in the cow, goat or dairy herd and a boarding contract under which

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the consumer boards the cow, goat or dairy herd in which 1 the consumer has an interest with the farmer for care and 2 milking, and under which the consumer is entitled to 3 receive a share of milk from the cow, goat or dairy herd; 4 5 6 Section 2. W.S. 11-36-102(a) (xiii), 11-36-110(a) by 7 creating a new paragraph (iv) are amended to read: 8 9 11-36-102. Definitions. 10 11 (a) As used in this act: 12 13 (xiii) "This act" means W.S. 11-36-101 through 14 11-36-11011-36-111. 15 16 11-36-110. 3	established by the department.
