**URGENT - PRODUCT RECALL NOTICE**

Taylor Farms, of Salinas CA is issuing a voluntary recall of certain lots codes of washed spinach. The Michigan Health Department tested a sample of the spinach and notified Taylor Farms that it has tested positive for a bacterial pathogen. The pathogen of concern is still unknown at this point and Taylor Farms is initiating this recall out of an abundance of caution.

The recall includes the below item and lot numbers only. These products are not to be consumed or served.

Please isolate any product with the listed lot numbers and destroy it in a secure manner to prevent unauthorized consumption. If you have product stored out of the case and are unsure of the code date please destroy this product also. Your distributor will be able to issue you credit. Please note that proper procedures must be followed and these cases may not be returned to your distributor.
